

# Bay-Lakes Soccer Association for Youth

Minutes of September 17, 2003, Kroll's West

1. The meeting was called to order by president Bill Bartelme at 6:33 PM
  2. MEMBERS PRESENT. Bill Bartelme (BL), Russ Reynolds (GBE), Bernie Bleuel (ALZ), Mary Jo Jetton (WRI), Kris Schumacher (GBW), Paul DeGrave (ALZ).
  3. ACCEPTANCE OF AGENDA (Bill Bartelme), accepted as written. Motion by Kris, second by Paul.
  4. SECRETARY'S REPORT (Paul DeGrave), Russ noted an error in the August minutes, the passed motion should read, "teams with 1 or more yellow cards per game will be excluded from the tournament." A motion to accept the amended August minutes was made by Russ, and seconded by Mary Jo.

    - REFEREE CODE OF ETHICS, discussion was tabled until we have better representation.
    - COACHES QUESTIONNAIRE, Bill is drafting the questionnaire and is looking for suggestions. The intent is to measure the change in quality of operations. It would only be mailed to "Area Coaches".
    - BAY-LAKES SAY CONSTITUTION and BY-LAWS, Tabled to October.
    - BAY-LAKES WEB SITE, Bill is considering using a combination of sites linked to our site. Eteamz for documents, Shutterfly for pictures, and All-Soccer for league standings.
    - NOMINATIONS FOR OFFICERS, Bill mentioned that Chick Hawkins will put his name in for either VP or Treasurer. Election will be at November meeting. Bill needs District Board Lists
